

#### STRUCTURE GOVERNANCE & MANAGEMENT

The charity is a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO) governed by a Constitution. Meadowbank Car 4U was granted charitable status on 29<sup>th</sup> February, 2016.

#### **Appointment of Trustees**

The current trustees were appointed by the members as charity trustees at the AGM held 27<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

#### Management

The trustees are responsible for the operation of the charity and meet on a regular basis and not less than every two months.

#### Objective

To deliver a free transport service to cancer patients from the three Doctors' Practices located within Meadowbank Health Centre, to and from hospital appointments/treatment sessions relating to their illness. Thereby:

Reducing the length of time the patient is away from home.

Improving their quality of life as journeys will be less stressful and more comfortable, and as a result they will be far less tired.

Provide a personal and supportive service, as if a friend were taking the person to hospital.

The transport is provided by volunteer drivers using their own cars for which they are paid a mileage allowance of 45p per mile.

#### Summary of our Activities

Our busiest month was November 2023 when we made 75 return trips and a close second was August, the quietest month was December 2023 when we only made 14 return trips. During the year we advertised for more volunteer drivers and have had some success, we now have 25 volunteer drivers.

We continue to receive regular referrals from the medical practices at Meadowbank Health Centre. Returning patients can contact our co-ordinators direct.

We advertise our service through social media, leaflets displayed in medical centres, chemist shops, library, and community centres.

The mileage allowance we pay remains at 45p per mile.

#### **Fundraising**

This year we held two of our regular fundraising events. We held a Partylite candle party and afternoon tea held at the Masonic Hall Brightons in October raising the sum of £443.00.

We also held a Quiz Night in The Venue Maddiston raising the sum of £692.00. Donations to our collection cans placed in local shops raised the sum of £1769.03. Personal donations amounted to £5,409.48 (including donations through Just Giving). We have also received financial donations from local organisations i.e. Provincial Grand Master and a Grant donation from The Albert Hunt Trust. We are very grateful for the level of support we receive locally and from other organisations, patients and their families.

#### Donated facilities and services.

Our volunteer drivers have driven 31533 miles and given approx. 1000 hours of their time. Our co-ordinators work from their own homes to keep costs at a minimum, each co-ordinator does two weeks co-ordinating every 10 weeks. We estimate that the coordinators have given 200 volunteer hours in the past year.

We have other volunteers who help with fundraising events, and we are grateful for their assistance.

The trustees would like to thank all our volunteers and spouses/partners for all their hard work.

#### Reserves

As can be noted in the accompanying Annual Accounts there was a small surplus of £714.23 for the year. No funds have been transferred to reserves this year and the total remains £5,500. All funds are unrestricted


