Arranging other sporting events with the aim of encouraging public participation in sport;

Inviting local community organisations and local individuals to take part in and contribute to the festivals and events;

Working with individual and community organisations in furtherance of the Charitable Purposes.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

Organised a running festival incorporating a Half Marathon road race, a trail race (approx. 8k) and a fun run for children.

The Half Marathon route was adapted and re-measured to meet the requirements for hosting the East District Half Marathon Championships within the event.

The trail race was adapted with a new, slightly shorter and more achievable route.

Engaged and liaised with local organisations including sports clubs, schools, scouts, guides to recruit and coordinate volunteers to help run the event.

Engaged with local schools and dance studios to coordinate entertainment and support along the routes.

Invited local businesses and organisations such as Greener Kirkcaldy, Andy's Man's Club etc. to participate in the event village.

Engaged with recreation businesses within the park to provide facilities to encourage more families into the event village.

Our signature half-marathon incorporating the East District Championships drew an impressive field of participants, ranging from seasoned club athletes - representing numerous local running clubs - to many first-time entrants at that distance and ages ranging from 17 to over 70. Along the route, enthusiastic residents lined the streets, creating an uplifting atmosphere for all competitors.

Our revised trail event, routed through nearby woodland paths, similarly attracted runners of diverse abilities. Some stepped up from "couch to 5K" programs to tackle the off-road 8km challenge, while others experienced their first-ever trail run - and feedback was overwhelmingly positive.

The highlight for sheer enthusiasm was the children's fun run. Designed as a non-competitive event, it boasted a strong turnout of young runners and delighted families, with countless beaming smiles at the finish.

Crucial to the weekend's success was our team of volunteers, drawn from across the community. While some were runners themselves, many were local youth groups, adults with disabilities, and residents of all ages—united by a shared desire to support the event and its village of activities.

Finally, the event enjoyed broad exposure through social media channels and on our community radio station, further amplifying our reach and engaging the wider Kirkcaldy area.
