Structure, governance and management

Type of governing document

The Trust is a Charity registered in Scotland, constituted by a Trust Deed Of 6th October 1978 and registered on 20th November 1978.

The following are "ex officio" Trustees:

Her Majesty's Lord Lieutenant of the county of Argyll, the Chairman,

the Secretary and the Treasurer, for the time being.

Council consists of the Trustees plus one representative from each of the Following areas: a) Lorn ,Balvicar and Easdale b) Campbeltown and Kintyre, c) Rothesay and Bute, d) Mull, Iona and Tiree, e) Cowal and Dunoon, f) Oban, g) Mid Argyll, Tarbert and Skipness, Lochgilphead,

Ardrishaig, Inveraray and Minard.

Trustee recruitment and appointment

Nomination of prospective Trustees may be made by Trustees or Council Members and the majority vote rules for approval of appointment. A minimum of three meetings are held annually to discuss Trust Business. During the period of Covid these were held virtually. This practice has now continued but we continue to meet face to face for the AGM which is normally held annually in June in Oban.

Objectives and activities

Charitable purposes

To enable and encourage ,within the Argyll and Bute area, young people to work together, and to provide charitable help for others of all ages in the community.

The Trust also helps groups or organisations with specific projects of a charitable nature

Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects

Trustees along with Members of Council meet to discuss the business affairs of the Trust and to award grants.

Applications are received in writing to the Members of Council or to the Trustees for consideration at our meetings.

When urgent requests are received, the Secretary will circularise these to Members and Trustees for consideration.

The bulk of our funds are invested and manged by Evelyn Partners who provide us with quarterly updates on the investment results and performance.

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

The Trustees aim to disburse grants totalling the Trusts annual investment which is now in the region of £12,000. This is dependant on the number of requests received and in this reporting year the sum of £6,500 has been granted to 8 deserving causes.

The largest one was the sum of £2,000 granted to the 19th Argyll Scouts who undertook most rewarding building and restoration works to schools in Katmandhu. Our usual level of grant is normally £500-£1,000 but as a "one off" in the year of King Charles's Coronation we gave £2,000.

During this financial year we were very fortunate to receive and entirely unexpected and most generous donation of £34,864.74. This was from the dissolution of a Charitable Trust in the name of the late Mrs J Y Nelson. These funds were immediately invested alongwith our existing funds with Evelyn and Partners. The income generated will be used towards future grants requests.

We recently had posters printed detailing the area in which we operate, alongwith what we do and examples of grants that we have paid. These are to be distributed throughout our area to promote our work and to encourage more applicants.

Financial review

Brief statement of the charity's policy on reserves

Th Trust continues to hold sufficient sums in in our Bank account to meet all outgoings and to fund grant applications throughout the year.

Investment income is received quarterly and credited to our Bank account.

Details of any deficit

No deficit occurred. In recent years any small deficit arose purely from investment of surplus funds in our bank account.




