This year has seen several speakers on various different photographic genres and subjects, some in person and some online. We try to vary our speakers so that we can widen the photographic knowledge of our members.

We continue to arrange monthly evening outings throughout the summer months for our membership.

We purchased and donated photographic accessories to the value of £213.45 (studio lighting and backdrop equipment) to our local High School, as proposed in our last report, and this was much appreciated by both staff and pupils.

Some of our Members took part in, and showed up well, in a Borderswide competition held in Galashiels. The club took part in an interclub competition showcasing our photographs against the other local clubs.

We were able to claim Gift Aid for Annual Membership during the year 2024/2025. This amounted to £190.20.
