Charitable purposes

Summary of main achievements during the financial period

The Charity has continued to deliver educational programmes through audio and visual formats to increase the reach and accessibility of our work. Our content aims to enhance the mental health and wellbeing of our audience while promoting arts, culture and heritage.

In addition to our digital educational activities, the Charity has started to work with partners to deliver youth clubs that provide young people with safe, inclusive spaces to learn, develop new skills, build confidence and engage in positive social and cultural activities. These sessions support personal development, community engagement and wellbeing.

Our main focus has been the production of educational audio-visual content highlighting the experiences and contributions of Black, Asian and Minority Ethnic (BME) and other minority communities. Through our online platforms, our educational content continues to reach many people, and we plan to further develop and consolidate both our digital programmes and youth activities in the coming year.

The activities of the Charity remain fully aligned with our SCIO charitable purposes and objectives.

Basis of independent examiner's statement

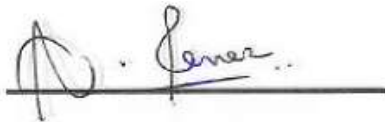
