 (b) Community Outreach: The organisation arranges community based programmes which address the felt needs of the people in the community.
 (c) Carrying out Baptism, Marriage, Funerals and Child dedication services.
 (d) Publication of literature: Leaflets, booklets and other printed materials shall be produced to inform and communicate the essence of the Christian doctrine.

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Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

- **Community Barbecue & Musical Outreach**

This event is traditionally held on a Sunday during the summer months as an opportunity to reach out to our immediate neighbourhood by sharing joy, fellowship, and food with the local community. The Neighbourhood Barbecue is a community-focused outdoor event; the last edition was held at Danestone Community Centre on Saturday, 9th August 2025. The event brought together people of all ages from the local community, creating a warm and welcoming atmosphere. Attendees enjoyed music, games, including football, and a generous selection of free food and refreshments. The atmosphere was filled with excitement, joy, laughter, and heartfelt praise to God Almighty. It was a wonderful opportunity for the entire RCCG Pavilion of Grace family to come together and demonstrate the love and joy of Jesus Christ and connect with our local community.

- **Children Fun Factory Event**

Our Fun Factory Event is a faith-based, child-focused community initiative designed to engage and inspire young children through fun, learning, and meaningful interaction. The event features a variety of enjoyable activities, including games, arts and crafts, and a bouncy castle, creating an environment where children can play, laugh, learn, and build lasting friendships. Alongside the fun activities, the children are taught biblical principles and values that encourage love, respect, kindness, and positive behaviour.

The programme is also designed to help children develop self-confidence, build healthy relationships, and appreciate the importance of treating others with love and respect. By nurturing these positive values from an early age, we hope to contribute to raising responsible, caring, and constructive members of the community as they grow into adulthood. In 2025, the Fun Factory Event, themed "Shield", took place on 13 September 2025. The activities, Bible stories, plays, and discussions focused on the importance of the word of God as a spiritual shield helping us to guard and guide our hearts, minds, behaviour and actions towards one another.

Achievements and performance:

- **Annual Community Christmas Carol**

The Community Christmas Carol is a much-loved annual celebration that brings together children, families, and adults from Bridge of Don and neighbouring communities. The 2025 edition, themed "The Prince of Peace" was held on Sunday, 14 December, at the main hall of Danestone Community Centre in Bridge of Don, Aberdeen. Christmas is a special season when Christians celebrate the birth of our Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, and the event beautifully captured the joy and spirit of the season. As our flagship community outreach event of the year, the Christmas Carol provided a meaningful opportunity to demonstrate and share the love of Christ through fellowship, generosity, and gift-giving. The celebration featured uplifting Christmas carols, the presentation of gifts to the children, and an abundance of food and refreshments for everyone. Every child and family received a gift pack, adding a special touch to an already memorable occasion. The event was warmly received by the community, and there is always a great anticipation for the next Christmas Carol event.

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- **Door-to-Door Evangelism and Tract Distribution**

Door-to-door evangelism is an important outreach activity through which we share the message of Jesus Christ with individuals and families within the local community. Volunteers visit homes, engage residents respectfully, offer prayer and encouragement, and distribute Christian tracts containing the Gospel message. The activity provides us the opportunity to demonstrate God's love, invite people to church, and encourage those who may be seeking spiritual guidance, while also helping church members develop confidence and compassion in sharing their faith.

- **Weekly Sunday School and Worship Service**

The weekly Sunday worship service provides an opportunity for the church family to come together to worship and glorify God through praise, prayer, Scripture reading, preaching, and fellowship. The service strengthens believers spiritually, encourages Christian fellowship, provides teaching and guidance from God's Word, and offers an opportunity for people to respond to the Gospel. It also creates a welcoming environment where individuals and families receive encouragement, build relationships, and grow together in faith.

- **Mid-Weekly Bible Study**

The weekly mid-week Bible study provides a more focused and interactive setting for studying and understanding the Word of God. Participants explore biblical teachings, discuss their practical application to everyday life, ask questions, and share insights and experiences in a supportive environment. The study helps members deepen their knowledge of Scripture, strengthen their faith, develop godly character, and apply biblical principles to their families, relationships, work, and wider community life.
