**INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT  
To The Trustees of Scottish Association Of Geography Teachers(SAGT)**

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 27 September 2025 which are set out on pages 4

**Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner**
