#### Governing Document

The Trust is governed by a Trust Deed and is administered by the committee whose members are elected at the Annual General Meeting.

### Objects and Activities

The objects of the Trust are to preserve Commercial Vehicles for posterity and to maintain records of Road Transport activities for historical research and educational purposes.

#### Financial Review

The principal sources of income are from members' subscriptions and the storage of vehicles. Open Weekend, Open Sundays and guided tours take place during the Summer. These have all helped to increase income. Books on transport subjects continue to be published.

Vehicle restoration costs have increased substantially.

The overall result is that a decreased surplus has been achieved.

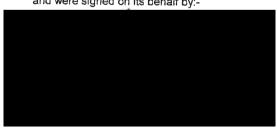

# REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT EXAMINER
