4. Supporting our people

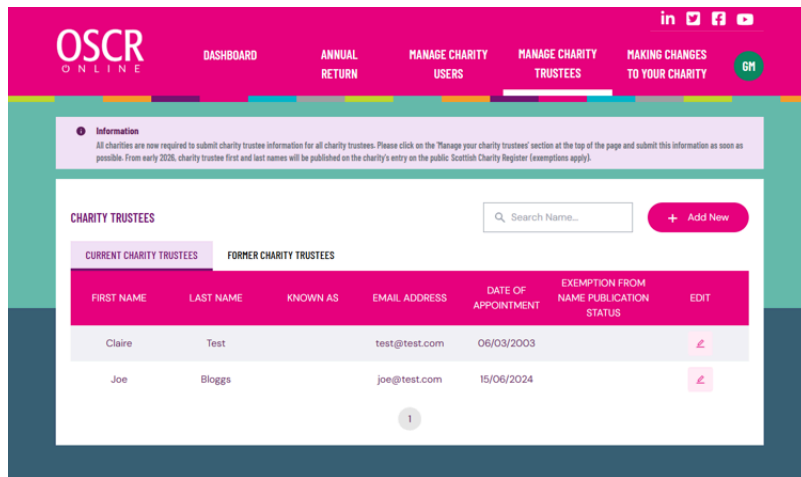


## We're recruiting for a new Chair of the Board
